

**The criteria for associate professor habilitation and professor appointment  
approved by Faculty of Economics and Management  
of Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra**

By the proposal for procedure of appointment as associate professor or professor, the applicant is considered as a complex scientific-pedagogic individual. The evaluation is performed considering the character of the main faculty activities, it is the reflection of the results as well as quality. The applicants for habilitation / inauguration are comprehensively evaluated by specialized commissions and Scientific Board of the faculty or university in accordance with valid higher education act and valid regulation of the Ministry of Education of the Slovak Republic governing the procedure for obtaining titles of associate professor and professor.

The following criteria are taken into consideration:

- The requirement for appointment of professors is teaching activity for a period of at least three years after receiving the title of associate professor in the field of study in which the candidate is awarded the degree of professor or in a related field of study. For the performance of educational activities is taken into account only the period during which the applicant was employed by the university, at least part-time in the range of at least half of the set weekly working time (including abroad), led lectures or seminars and supervised doctoral students.
- The requirement for obtaining the degree of associate professor is teaching activity for a period of at least three years after obtaining higher third-level education in particular, giving lectures on selected chapters, teaching on seminars and exercises, respectively corresponding forms of teaching.
- For applicants outside FEM SUA in Nitra (FEM) is required a proof of cooperation, for example, in the form of selective lectures, project work or publishing with the employees of FEM.

- article in a journal recorded in the international professional database of WOS or Scopus as a top international quality; usually for the top international quality article is considered an output in a scientific journal with  $HI \geq 10$  or  $IF \geq 0.25IFM$
- article in a proceedings of the world congress/conference issued in renowned international publishing house; usually registered in WOS or Scopus
- a monograph published in a reputable foreign publisher (eg. Elsevier, Springer, Palgrave, Wiley, etc.)
- a study in the journal or proceedings having character of the scientific monograph published in a reputable foreign publisher
- a chapter in a monograph published in a foreign renowned publishing house
